Visit *Changing Places*, an exhibit at Levine Museum of the New South that explores the realities, myths and misconceptions about the cultures and people that are changing the face of Charlotte and the region. After all, you're one of them.

Be part of a new teen dialogue experience and "Turn the Tables" ... talk, listen and learn from each other as you explore themes from the exhibit, including stereotypes and the cultural transformation occurring in the region.

what is it?

Turns the Tables is a 2 hour group experience for youth and teens that includes an exhibit visit and facilitated discussion focused on stereotypes in a changing community.

Groups may consist of up to 30 individuals ages 12 years and older. The dialogues are designed for all types of youth and teen groups, such as clubs, camps, ministries, service groups, alliances and community organizations.

Participants will leave with a deeper cross-cultural understanding and increased self-awareness of how they can be catalysts for creating positive change in their homes, schools and community.
